**EIM BASIC WORKSHOP** - A 3-hour Ethics and Integrity in Ministry (EIM) Basic Workshop will be held Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2014 from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. in the Parish Center Cafeteria. **Please login to your EIM account (use the Alternate Login option if needed) to pre-register to attend an EIM workshop several days in advance of the workshop.** This workshop is part of the diocesan EIM policies that were adopted in January 2002 and revised in August 2008. All clergy and paid staff and all volunteers in any ministry at any parish or diocesan location, are required to complete a one-time Application for Ministry prior to beginning their work/service and attend an EIM workshop within 60 days of submitting the application. Please login to your EIM account (use the Alternate Login option if needed) to pre-register to attend an EIM workshop. Please do not bring children to an EIM workshop. Materials used in the workshop include testimonies from victims and perpetrators of sexual abuse. To create a new account, select How to Become EIM Compliant (new applicant) and follow instructions from there.
