**Feast of Christ the King** This passage from Matthew might be considered a list of essential duties for a follower of Christ. The Gospel points out that Jesus speaks about the "nations" who gather, so we can see this as both an individual and communal response to God. As individuals and as a community, are we able to see Christ in the needy, the least, the poorest and the forgotten? Our yes, to accepting the Kingdom depends on our willingness to see and respond to them as we would to Christ.

**Rachel's Reflections** -- "For years I was miserable at Christmas, although I must admit I had no idea it had anything to do with my abortion. There was no room in my heart for God and I would become locked in to depression and sadness and not knowing why I couldn't be joyful like everyone else. It took a long time before I recognized it was because a part of my family was not there, the son I had aborted. I had said "no" to God and there was a child missing that I would never buy toys for. I was centered on the "me" of Christmas instead of the "Him." The Mystery of the Incarnation ... God chose to come to earth as an infant and to take our sins upon Himself so that we may be saved. Mercy Himself was born to us this day, setting the stage for the Crucifixion and Resurrection which would open the

gates of heaven to repentant sinners." -
