ST. MARY'S CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS 2016

1). No monuments over 4 feet tall with 6 foot base for double and 3 foot base for single. 2). No Cement slabs allowed. 3). Benches are allowed as long as on your lot. If not on your lot you must purchase a lot for bench. Not allowed at foot of lot only at head of lot. 4). Cemetery not responsible for maintenance of monuments in place. Such as re-leveling, discoloring, graffiti, broken vases and other things. 5). No new curbing allowed. 6). Owner of cemetery lots cannot sell them to someone else. They can give them to someone in the family or sold back to cemetery for original purchase price. 7). Water only when present. No sprinklers allowed. Do not leave water running. 8). Secondary monuments at head only. Veteran markers at foot even with ground. 9). Limit flowers and ornaments to monument only. Remove others. 10). No planting of trees, rose bushes, and other flowers. They will be removed. 11). No gun ammunition allowed on grass and monuments. 12). Please remove all wind chimes and other subjects from trees also no free standing chimes they fall and are a mowing hazard. 13). When putting new flowers please remove old ones. 14). When decorating for birthdays and other holidays please remove items 1 week after said holiday. 15). As of June 1st lots will be \$600 for parishioners and \$1200 for non-parishioners. A person must be a registered contributing parishioner to receive the parishioner discount.
