CHRISTMAS SCHEDULE -- Because this year has the Fourth Sunday of Advent lasting only the Sunday morning of the 24th, we will need to adjust the Sunday Mass schedule a bit to allow for more time between Masses, due to the greater expected attendance. This will assist with parking, as well as give the clergy and people a sufficient break between liturgies, to be properly disposed to celebrate them, reverently and prayerfully. Please be mindful that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and the obligation to attend Christmas Mass as a holy day of obligation are separate and BOTH apply—that means that we are obligated to attend both the Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent as well as one of the Christmas Masses.
